

















## 2017 Youth Summer Reading Program Guidelines

-  The Summer Reading Program is for readers and nonreaders from birth through age seventeen.
-  Participants may read or listen to books at home.
-  Participants may sign up in the Youth Services Department the first time books are returned for credit or at any time throughout the program.
-  First Day to count books: **Tuesday, May 30th, 2017.**
-  Only books checked out from the Pittsburg Public Library will be counted for credit.
-  Books cannot be checked out and returned on the same day.
-  Return items to the **Summer Reading Program Book Drop**, located in the Library's lobby.
-  Each participant will fill out his/her own Book Count Slip, available at the book drop. Take this slip to the Youth Services Department for credit on the same day the books are returned.
-  To earn tickets for prizes, swim passes, and/or Mini-Golf, participants must complete the reading requirements in one of the following categories:
  - 10 Picture books or Primary books.
  - 5 Juvenile, Young Adult, or Adult books with 60 to 130 pages.
  - 3 Juvenile, Young Adult, or Adult books with 131+ pages.
-  Participants receive a prize for each category completed. Participants receive one (1) free admission to the Pittsburg Aquatic Center **or** Pittsburg Mini-Golf. **The pass is good for the following week only.** Participants may earn one (1) pass per week only, with a limit of six (6) admissions during the course of the program. Thank you to Pittsburg Parks & Recreation and the City of Pittsburg for supporting readers!
-  Pittsburg Mini-Golf passes require one paid adult admission.
-  The first three (3) times a participant completes the requirements in a category, he/she will receive a ticket to choose an exciting prize from the Treasure Hut.
-  Last day to turn in books for credit: **Saturday, July 29th, 2017.**
-  The reading program will conclude with a Wrap Party on Friday, August 4th at 6:00 p.m. at Lincoln Center, 9th Street, Lincoln Park. Doors open at 5:45 p.m.
